The first banquet will be Tuesday, July 12th during pistol week and the second will be Thursday August 4th during Rifle week. Both events will be at the RED HORSE next door to Camp Perry, doors open at 5PM with dinner starting at 7PM. Speaking of dinner, this year, guests will be treated to a steak dinner with all the trimmings. Dinner tickets are \$30 each and also get you a strip of raffle tickets. Spring Pistol Shoot Roundup
